❖ MANNERS

Formal titles should always be used with people older than yourself.

Once you know someone's name, use it instead of Anda(you)

Sir	Pak (short for Bapak)
Ms/Mrs	Ibu
How are you?	Apa Kabar?
I am good	Baik baik
Please (when asking for something)	Tolong
Please (when offering something)	Selahkan

Can I? (Sit down)
I am happy to meet you

Boleh? (duduk)
Saya senang bertemu Anda
